Pupil Premium 2015-2016

For the academic year 2015-2016 Riston C.E Primary School received a total of £15,840 for Pupil Premium Funding.

In order to reduce the attainment gap in those pupils who attract the pupil premium funding, we offered the following support:

- small group phonics teaching in FS and KS1
- small group English intervention/support for KS1 pupils who are making less than expected progress
- teacher and/or TA guided support groups in Maths and English to support pupils who are making less than expected progress
- TA led activities/support for social and emotional programmes for both individuals and small groups
- smaller teaching groups for all classes support raising attainment in English and Maths
- purchased effective materials aimed at raising standards, particularly in writing, reading and mathematics.

The impact of the above interventions and support programmes from Pupil Premium funding was:

- the impact of phonics teaching meant 89% of the pupils at the end of year 1 achieved a Good Level of Development in reading, making good progress.
- of the targeted group of KS1 pupils who received English support and / or interventions, the majority made expected progress
- targeted pupils who received support for Maths and English made at least average progress in Maths, Reading and Writing
- social and emotional programmes had a positive impact with identified pupils involved with less incidents and difficulties during the school day
- resources purchased contributed to raising attainment.
